Objective: To provide quality education in a safe and nurturing environment for children from underprivileged backgrounds.

- **Key Activities:**
- Early childhood development through play-way learning.
- Focused sessions on motor skill development and nutrition.
- providing children safe spaces / Nutrition and health masks.

A year with unique challenges

The onset of the pandemic in 2020 marked an unprecedented crisis, severely impacting the SHIKSHA program. Until March, children participated in regular batches, but lockdowns disrupted this continuity. Providing nutritional supplements and maintaining educational engagement became major challenges. Migration of families added another layer of complexity, as many children relocated, making consistent support difficult. Despite these hurdles, Sparsha adapted by leveraging digital tools, distributing educational kits, and ensuring nutritional needs were met through community outreach programs.


Outcome



- Foster a supportive environment to help children build emotional resilience and social skills.
- Promote empathy, teamwork, and positive communication through group activities, storytelling, and role-play exercises.
- Over 85% of children showed improved interaction and teamwork skills during group activities.
- Children demonstrated greater confidence and a reduction in behavioral issues, as noted by teachers and parents



- Ensure children have access to balanced nutrition, improving their physical abilitiath Conductognifisher health check-ups, and provide guidance on hygiene and wellness.
- 90% of children exhibited improved health metrics, such as weight-for-age and height-forage indicators, following nutritional support.

- Regular health of identified early signs timely deficiencies, allowing interventions for Y children.



- Empower children with basic self-care and practical skills like personal hygiene, dressing, and managing daily routines. Conduct workshops to build independence
- workshops to build independence and confidence in managing everyday activities.
- Over 70% of participants achieved independence in basic daily tasks, fostering selfreliance. noticeable
- Parents reported children impracing personal hygiene and organizing their daily routines.

Our Program Impact


1.Enhanced Emotional Well-Being: Children are now better equipped to handle challenges with significant improvements in social and emotional intelligence.
