Addressing Educational and Livelihood Challenges for Girls and Families

Objective: The SWAYAM program aims to prepare youth (aged 15-18) for self-reliance by equipping them with vocational skills, digital literacy, and academic support to ensure their educational continuity and future employability.

Key Objectives:

Bridging Learning Gaps in Core Subjects

 Conducting remedial batches for English, Math, and Science to address learning gaps caused by auto-promotion.

Promoting Higher Education for Girls

- Providing financial and academic support to girls facing familial resistance to education.
- Offering counseling and mental health support to keep them motivated and engaged.

Preventing Child Labour & Strengthening Family Livelihoods

- Supporting children at risk of dropping out due to financial hardships.
- Training parents under the Saksham Program in gardening, pet care, and senior citizen care to create alternative income sources.

Empowering Youth through Digital Literacy & Leadership

- Training students as digital champions to enhance online learning accessibility within their communities.
- Conducting digital literacy workshops to improve technology access and education.

Fostering Holistic Development & Well-being

- Organizing sports, yoga, meditation, and mental health sessions to promote emotional well-being.
- Encouraging leadership and teamwork through peer-led community initiatives.

Each initiative empowers individuals, enhances education, and builds sustainable livelihoods.

Key Challenges Affecting Education:

- Lack of support for girls' education limits higher study opportunities.
- Auto-promotion results in academic loss and lack of clarity in core subjects.
- Economic hardship drives children to work as laborers.
- · Parental unemployment hinders children's educational continuity.

Overcoming Challenges:

- Educational Sponsorship for Girls: Supported 13 girls with financial aid and mentoring for higher studies.
- Remedial and Special Batches: Offered remedial classes in English, Math, and Science to address academic gaps.
- Counseling and Mental Health Support: Provided regular counseling to support children's emotional well-being and motivate education.
- Preventing Child Labor through Family Empowerment: Trained parents in skills like gardening and caregiving, enabling them to secure local jobs and keep children in education.

Key Impact Highlights:

• Strengthening Academic Foundations

Remedial Classes: Special batches for English, Math, and Science to address conceptual gaps. Average Attendance: 92%, indicating strong engagement and commitment to learning.

- Number of girls retained in school: Increased significantly due to continuous counseling, sponsorships, and family engagement.

- Trained parents in alternative livelihood skills (gardening, pet care, senior citizen care) under the Saksham program, ensuring financial stability.


