# SWAYAM PROGRAM

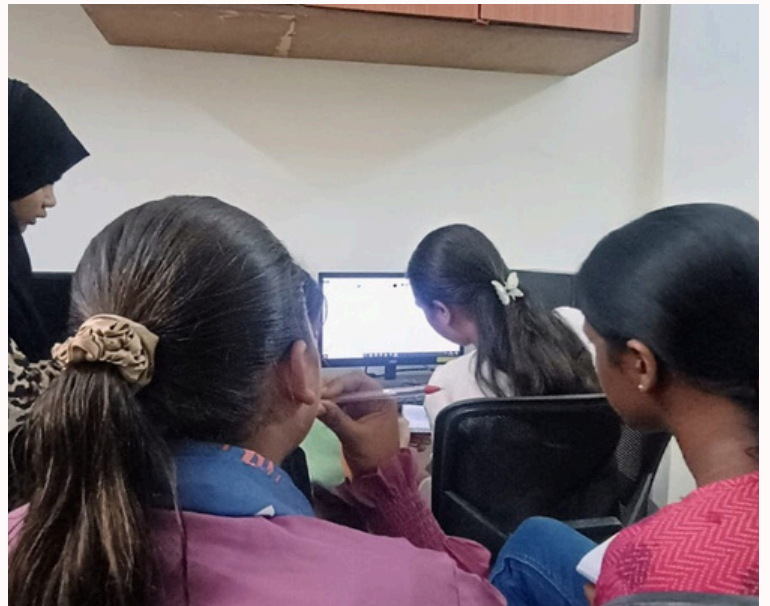
## Our Activities in November
