- 20th September 2025: Kamla Nagar – 116 beneficiaries received support for services like Aadhaar Card, PPF Sukanya Samriddhi Accounts, and E-Shram registration.
- 21st September 2025: Kokari – 119 beneficiaries were assisted with the same services.
