A Year of Growth & Achievement : The year 2024-25 marked a milestone for the SHIKSHA program, with children actively engaging in learning while also preparing for formal education. Teachers and animators played a crucial role in supporting parents during the school admission process, ensuring smooth transitions for 28 young learners.

Children thrived in an environment of innovative activities, building not only academic readiness but also essential life skills through role play, group interactions, and creative exercises. Events like sports day and field trips provided joy and learning outside the classroom, while parent-child activities strengthened family bonds and reinforced positive parenting.

Objective: To provide early childhood education for children aged 3–6 years using the play-way method, focusing on phonics, concept formation, ADL (Activities of Daily Living) skills, socialization, and health & nutrition for holistic school readiness.

KEY ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED

- Phonics, Concept Formation, ADL & Socialization Sessions—Conducted regularly throughout the year.
- Monthly Health & Nutrition Sessions – Focused on balanced diet, hygiene, and well-being.
- Parent Interaction Sessions – 12 sessions conducted to build awareness and improve engagement.
- Exposure Visits – Visits to market, dairy, fire station, post office to promote experiential learning.
- Celebrations & Awareness Activities –
- Janmashtami celebration
- Nutrition sessions with interactive games
- Christmas party & Puppet show on health & hygiene
- Food distribution & awareness on “Good Touch & Bad Touch” for children

KEY OUTCOMES

- 82% demonstrated stronger emotional expression and confidence.

Health & Well-Being:

- 88% of children showed improved understanding of nutrition, hygiene, and safety.
- Puppet show and nutrition games reinforced positive health habits.

Parental Engagement:

- 12 structured parent interaction sessions were held with 80% participation, ensuring consistent involvement in children's progress.

Experiential & Cultural Learning:

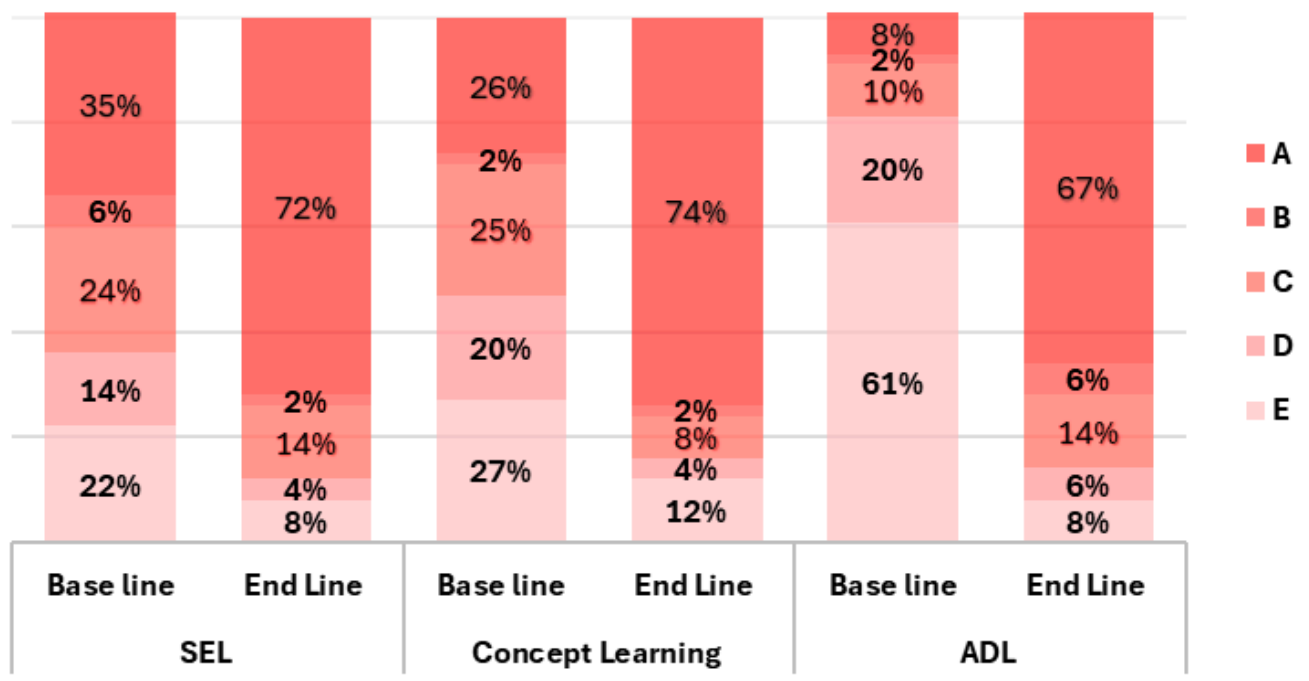
- Visits to the market, dairy, fire station, and post office enhanced practical learning and awareness.
